Adult Competition – General Information

- Qualifications*
- The competition is open to ISKF US members only ages 18+.
 - There are no limits to the number of competitors from one region.
 - Competitors must compete only in their correct division as decided by their age and rank as of Oct. 26, 2024.
 - Competitors must show current ISKF membership cards at check-in.
 - Competitors must show ISKF Passports at check-in.
-

- Safety Precautions*
- Mouthpieces and ISKF-approved white non-absorbent hand protectors are required for all competitors in kumite, regardless of rank.
 - No eye glasses or safety glasses will be permitted during kumite events.
 - For kumite, female competitors may wear chest protectors, worn inside the gi jacket; male competitors may wear protective cups.
 - Absolutely no jewelry of any type will be permitted to be worn by competitors or officials male or female.

Adult Individual Events

- Adults 18-44*
- There will be no beginner or intermediate divisions.
 - There will be separate divisions for Individual Brown and Black Belts.
 - Brown Belt divisions will finish on Saturday, Oct. 26th.
 - Eliminations for black belt events will be on Saturday; finalists from each event will compete in the finals on Sunday, Oct. 27th.
 - Each region of the ISKF US may seed the top 4 competitors from its region in each of the Adult 18-44 Black Belt Individual events.
-

- Adults 45+*
- Only brown and black belts may compete and will be combined.
 - Competitors aged 55-64 will choose between *jiyu* and *jiyu ippon* kumite.
 - Competitors aged 65+ will do kata only; no kumite competition.
 - Eliminations will be on Saturday; finalists from each event will compete in the finals on Sunday, Oct. 27th.

Adult Team Events

- Team Kata*
- Each ISKF region may send two 18-44 men's teams, two 18-44 women's teams and two 45+ teams (genders may be mixed).
 - Competitors in different age divisions may not mix.
 - Eliminations will be on Saturday, Oct 26th with finals on Sunday.

- Team Kumite*
- Each ISKF region may send two 18-44 men's teams and two 18-44 women's teams; there is no team kumite competition for 45+ competitors.
 - Each team will consist of three members and one alternate.
 - Eliminations will be on Saturday, Oct 26th with finals on Sunday.

Collegiate Competition – General Information

- Qualifications*
- The National Collegiate Karate Tournament is open to ISKF US members who are full-time undergraduate or graduate students enrolled at a college, university or junior college in the United States.
 - Competitors must be at least 18 years old and brown or black belt.
 - A student may compete in the Collegiate division for a maximum of 4 years.
 - There are no limits to the number of competitors from one school.
 - Competitors must show current ISKF membership cards at check-in.
 - Competitors must show ISKF Passports at check-in.
 - Competitors must show proof of current semester full-time student status at check-in.
 - We reserve the right to combine/adjust divisions based on the number of registered competitors.
-

- Safety Precautions*
- Mouthpieces and ISKF-approved white non-absorbent hand protectors are required for all competitors in kumite, regardless of rank.
 - No eye glasses or safety glasses will be permitted during kumite events.
 - For kumite, female competitors may wear chest protectors, worn inside the gi jacket; male competitors may wear protective cups.
 - Absolutely no jewelry of any type will be permitted to be worn by competitors or officials male or female.

- Team Kata*
- Each school may send one brown and black belt kata team of mixed gender.
 - A kata team is composed of three members and one alternate.
 - All members of a collegiate team must be from the same college/university.

- Team Kumite*
- Each school may send one women's team and one men's team.
 - Each kumite team consists of three members and one alternate.
 - All members of a collegiate team must be from the same college/university.

- All collegiate team events will conclude on Saturday, Oct. 26th.

Youth Competition – General Information

- Qualifications**
- The competition is open to ISKF US members only between the ages of 7 and 17 years old as of October 26, 2024.
 - There are no limits to the number of competitors from one region.
 - Competitors must show current ISKF membership cards at check-in.
 - Competitors 3rd kyu and above must show ISKF Passports at check-in.
 - We reserve the right to combine/adjust divisions based on the number of registered competitors.

- Safety Precautions**
- Mouthpieces and ISKF-approved white non-absorbent hand protectors are required for all competitors in kumite, regardless of age or rank.
 - No eye glasses or safety glasses will be permitted during kumite events.
 - For kumite, female competitors may wear chest protectors, worn inside the gi jacket; male competitors may wear protective cups.
 - Absolutely no jewelry of any type will be permitted to be worn by competitors or officials male or female.
